

9ª Jornada Social

Santarém - Pará - 2022



The Jornada Social (Social Journey) is a Marom project of the Shalom Community. For 8 years we have organized editions of this program, enabling an experience of social exchange with communities around the world.

A gente acredita que os indivíduos se desenvolvem a partir das relações. E que as vivências comunitárias são experiências muito potentes. E assim funciona a Jornada: é um processo vivido em grupo, grupo que é recebido por uma outra comunidade, comunidade na qual vivemos e trabalhamos juntos, aprendendo nos enquanto: enquanto come junto, enquanto trabalha junto, enquanto anda junto, enquanto bate papo despretensiosamente, enquanto ri, enquanto se emociona, enquanto percorre a jornada.



In this year 2022, the journey takes place in an extraordinary way, this time we are not going to immerse ourselves in a community in a vulnerable situation, we are not going to a quilombola community in Maranhão or in the largest favela in Kenya, we are going to live with a community of volunteers and professionals of health.

This year we will live for a week on a hospital-boat, the Abaré boat, which provides medical care to riverside communities along the Tapajós River, in Pará, Brazil. We will make our immersion in this community that is dedicated to bringing care and health to remote places, in a unique delivery, staying away from their homes and their families for a greater purpose.



And this year we will not be alone! We will work together with the NGO ZOÉ, which is a non-profit association that supports Amazonian populations with limited access to health care.

Our Journey takes place from the 1st to the 11th of December, having one meeting before, the immersion weekend! A special weekend in which we will understand all the details of this project (still no date set).



It has the cost of the land part of R\$ 1000.00 (about \$ 200.00 dollars) per person, with the possibility of subsidies. (air not included)

Among our activities are the reception of patients, organization of medical records, assisting doctors in the consultations, and also the care services for the boat and the team, such as cooking!



As in all journeys we will have some challenges, such as sleeping in hammocks, living on a boat and the heat. But this is small compared to the joys that the journey can bring us! We'll talk more about this at our immersion meeting!
